History

Sheldon Family Practice Associates began in 1988, previously owned and operated by Dr. Ronald Zoutendam. In 1988, Northwest Iowa Health Center purchased the clinic then joined Sioux Valley Health System in 1991.

In 1992 a satellite clinic was added in Sanborn, IA. A new clinic, located behind the hospital in Sheldon, opened in 1996 and a year later a satellite clinic opened in Hartley, IA. Dr. Zoutendam retired in 2003. In 2007, in conjunction with Sioux Valley facilities, we changed our name to Sanford Sheldon Medical Center. In 2008 we opened a satellite clinic in Boyden, IA.

Scheduling

We try our best to stay on schedule; however, emergencies may cause unforeseen delays. Because we know your time is valuable we will notify you of interruptions whenever possible.

If you or a family member is ill and needs to be seen, calling early in the day makes scheduling an appointment easier.

If you are unable to keep your appointment, please call and cancel as far in advance as possible so the time can be available to other patients.

After Hours Care

A Sanford Clinic Sheldon physician is on-call 24 hours a day for the Sanford Sheldon Medical Center Emergency Room. For after hours emergencies, call the hospital at (712) 324-5041.

Patient Information

All information relating to patient care is held in confidence. Before information can be released to any other entity, a release signed by the patient, or a guardian, is required.

Billing and Insurance

Payment is due at the time of service. Your insurance coverage is between you and your insurance company, and the account is your responsibility. Monthly statements on accounts are mailed. Sanford Clinic Sheldon is happy to file insurance and Medicare claims; however, it is imperative that accurate account information is on-file. Claims will only be submitted if complete information is available. If you have questions regarding this policy, please contact the Sanford Sheldon Clinic office.

Helpful Hints

- If you suspect your child is ill, be prepared to give the following information when you call: child's temperature, age, symptoms and length of time symptoms have been present.
- Check the expiration date on prescriptions to avoid running out.
- Sanford Clinic Sheldon, Sanborn, Hartley and Boyden will administer allergy shots. For your safety, the patient must wait 20 minutes after the injection to monitor for allergic reaction.
- Please bring your insurance card to your appointment.
- Be prepared to make your co-payment at the time of service.
